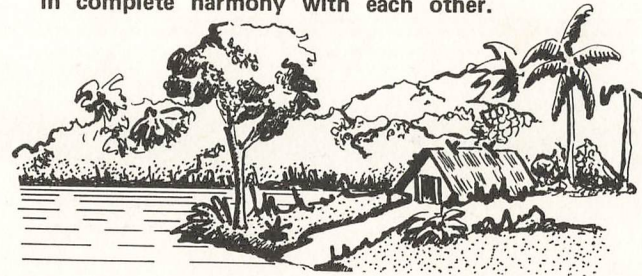

Radio SRS, a government owned station, was founded in 1965. We transmit on three frequencies: 725 Kc 50 Kw AM transmitter; 96.4 Mh F.M. 10 Watt transmitter and on S.W. 1 Kw on 4.7 Mh or 60 m. Our main purpose is to serve the local population with news, music and other entertainment and educational programs. We broadcast daily from 5 a.m. till 24.00 p.m. (local time).

We have a total amount of 26 full time employees in our service and another 26 part time workers in different fields. We are planning to expand our commitments to a wider caribbean broadcast by introducing a 10 Kw shortwave transmitter this year.

Surinam is situated in the northern part of South America and is bounded on the north by the Atlantic, to the west Guyana, to the east French Guyana and to the south Brasil.

Our total surface is 162.000 km and we have a population of 400.000 inhabitants. We are a tropic country with different racial groups. The major races are Negroes, Indians, Chinese, Javanese, Amerindians and Whites. Our main export products are bauxite, aluminum, wood, rice, sugar, bananas and other agricultural products. Surinam is a former Dutch colony. We became independent in November (25th) 1975 after 350 years of Dutch colonisation. Our lingua franca is the "Sranang tongo" (the Surinam language) but Dutch is officially spoken in the schools, universities, offices and shops. Besides, many other languages are spoken due to the many ethnic groups who live in complete harmony with each other.





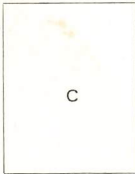
