The UAE Radio from Abu Dhabi was set up on 25th of February 1969 under the name of Abu Dhabi Radio with six hours transmission in Arabic only. With the formation of the seven Trucial Emirates into a Federation "The United Arab Emirates" on 2nd December 1971, Abu Dhabi Radio assumed the present name and has grown enormously since then.

The foreign Language services of Abu Dhabi Radio transmit (beside the short-wave service) in English, French, Urdu, Bengali and F.M programme (Capital Radio) to listeners inside the country on M/W band. The task of the F.L.S is to convey to non-Arab residents a comprehensive and realistic picture of political, economic and cultural life in the UAE as well as UAE's viewpoint on current affairs and problems of International significance.

THE UNITED ARAB EMIRATES, is located on the northern coast of the Arabian Gulf stretching deeper through the Gulf of Oman. It's bordered by the Arabian Gulf to the north west, Qatar and the Kingdom of Saudi Arabian to the south. Sultanate of Oman and the Gulf of Oman to the East. It lies between latitude 22-28.5 (North) and longitude 51-56.5 (East). The UAE was proclaimed independent on December 2, 1971. As a Union of seven Emirates : Abu Dhabi, Dubai, Sharjah, Ras Al Khaimah, Umm Al Quwain, Ajman and Fujeirah.

The UAE is considered as one of the best winter resort in the world because, of its location in the tropical area, it has tremendous potential in tourism, the blue shallow water of its 900 km. clean white sandy beaches is ideal for sunbathing, swimming fishing and sailing.

The UAE has an area of 91,700 sq.km. Its climate is moderate from October to April it starts to heat up gradually after April until it becomes quite hot and humid in the summer especially in the months of July and August.

The population of the UAE is over 1.5 million according to 1986 census. Most of them are engaged in oil industries, trade and fishing. Visitors to the UAE are immediately struck by the cosmopolitan atmosphere that prevail all over the country, this is evident from the presence of people from virtually every part of the world.

Islam is the religion of the country and the Government has taken special interest to propagate the Islamic principles of tolerance, co-operation and modesty. At present UAE has more than 2,000 Mosques capable of accomodating 300,000 worshipers.

Arabic is the official language of the country but English is widely used.

Oil constitutes the backbone of UAE national economy and represents 95 percent of the GNP. Despite lower oil revenues, the UAE recorded the world's highest per capita (\$ 19,000) in 1986 according to the World Bank. The official currency in the UAE. is Dirham which is equivalent to 0.27 US Dollar.
