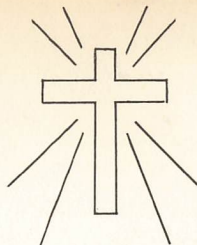

Dear Sir:

Your SWL report has been received here at Radio Cordac. As checked with the station log, it is correct as reported after 0430 GMT. The preceding program is a music variety one with no speaking or singing. You must have heard an interfering station.

It continues to amaze us that our signals can be heard throughout the world because we operate on very low power (2500 watts) with only an ordinary diapole antenna. We have plans for higher power and have on hand the latest design LPA high-gain antenna. We are seeking to receive permission to build our permanent antenna site.

It sounds like your work is very interesting and challenging. I don't believe I have ever visited your area but it must be beautiful. Perhaps some time when we are on furlough, we can pass your way.

Thanks again for the report and enclosed cards and stamps. We will send along a few of our stamps. We hope you find them interesting.
