Radio Biafra, the External Service of the Voice of Biafra operates on a 10 years old 10 Kilowatt Short wave transmitter re-installed, serviced and maintained exclusively by Biafran engineers. It is gratifying that after two years of hard work that little voice of TRUTH and JUSTICE is no longer a still voice in the wilderness.
