Thank you for your reception report dated 5th October 1988. I can confirm your record of our transmission, which was as shown in your letter.

This station is the latest addition to the BBC's group of relay's around the world. It started transmission on the 25th September 1988, the service area is from Ethiopia in the north, to Mozambique in Southern Africa.

You may be interested in some technical details about the station.

Transmitters - 2 Marconi 250Kw with fully Automatic tuning and remote control.

Programme Feed - Via Intelsat ∇ from London, 10 metre dish and earth station on site.

Antennas - 6 Marconi wide band arrays each covering 4 Short Wave broadcast bands.

Feeders - Kabel Metal 9 inch coax.
