Thankyou for your reception report. Your QSL card is enclosed, and we hope you will enjoy adding it to your collection.

In case you are interested in some technical details of our transmissions, we are using 2 kilowatts of power, radiated from a log periodic antenna. Our site is 600 geet high overlooking the harbour and the city of Victoria, on the east coast of Mahe, the major island of the Seychelles group. Our antenna is perched atop a masyt 70 feet up on this site, giving us a salt water path for our transmissions.

The purpose of FEBA - Seychelles is to share with you the Good News of our Lord, Jesus Christ. For we have come to know that He is our Saviour, who paid the penalty of our sins, large and small. If you would like to know more about Him, do write and let us know.

We would value further reports fo reception from you, on this and any other frequencies we may use.
