RECEPTION REPORT

We thank you very much for your reception report dated ~~3rd~~ 3rd November, 1975. We are pleased to note that you are able to receive our 9730 kHz transmission in the U. S. A. This frequency is in use on the North African service between 1900 hrs and 2100 hours GMT.

We also operate a West African service on frequency 16325 kHz between 1800 and 1900 hours GMT. We hope soon to be able to broadcast to Southern Europe when the aerial erection is completed. We use a 250 KW transmitter for our external service.

Reception reports of this kind are very helpful to us and we look forward to hearing from you again in the near future.
