Dear Mr. Dexter :

Your letter dated Aug. 24th, 1980, which was sent to the Korean Embassy in Washington, has been referred to my attention through the Korean Ministry of Culture and Information.

We also received your reception report on one of our local domestic programs transmitted in Taegu, located in the country's southern portion. We are pleased to inform you that the time and frequency that you noted in the report proved to correspond exactly to the transmission schedule of the local station. But, according to our technical staff, they discontinued transmitting on that frequency as of June this year.

And, one thing that we'd like you to know is ; after inquiring of the Taegu station about the missing letter, which you said you had sent them in 1978, we've found that they did not receive it. What happened was; the letter was delivered to the Taegu American Forces Korea Network, possibly by the mistake of the postman. Thus, there they sent the letter back to your address. So, if you have not received it, we imagine that it might have been lost on the way.

After all, your letter and reception report have never been received by the Taegu Station.

Enclosed you will find some materials, which will help you to listen to our overseas service.

Thanking you for your interest in our station KBS, and hoping that we will hear from you again by way of letter or reception report, I remain
