Thank you very much for your two letters: one dated November 8, 1975 and the other March 19, 1977. We are sorry for being unable to answer you promptly. This is due to some circumstances which cause such a long delay. We hope you will render us an excuse.

May we take this opportunity to thank you again for your reception report on our two regional short wave stations broadcast on frequencies of 7.385 MKZ at Savannakhet and 6.510 (not 6.89 MKZ) at Laaung Prabang.

The transmitter in Savannakhet is the U.S.A. made type rated at 1 KW feeding the horizontal wire " T " multiband aerial. The second one is quite close to that of Luang Prabang, but the transmitter is somehow deviated. The actual frequency is 6510 KHZ. The station is now out of order. At present Luang Prabang station broadcast on frequency of 4762 KHZ 63 M band. This Chinese S.W. made type has the power of 1 KW.

We hope these details will be of some value for your work. We are looking forward to hearing from you again.
