You will find enclosed a greeting Card from RADIO CARAIBES with our warm wishes for much success in your very important job and our wishes that you could learn french during this present year 1967.

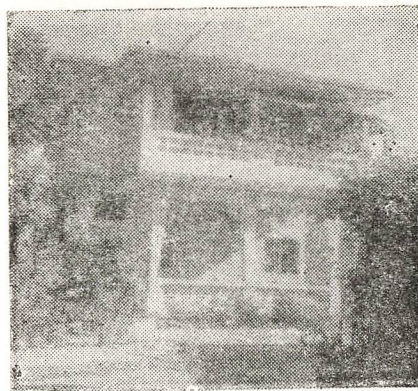
