Dear Mr. Dexter:

In the absence of Mr. Loran Veith, who is the director of TGBA I opened your letter in which you send us a reception report for the night of the 23rd of November of last year. We sincerely appreciate your report. It is interesting to hear how far out our signal is being picked up.

We broadcast with a Collins 300G transmitter using a horizontal antenna, folded dipole, 63 meters long, supporter between 2,90' television type towers. We have about 300 watts on antenna.

We operate in 6 of the Indian languages of western Guatemala, and in Spanish. The station here is owned and operated by the Central American Mission, with headquarters in Dallas, Texas.

Mr. Veith evidently received your earlier report, as I have seen your card and penant around, either in the station or in his home. No doubt the press of duties has kept him from answering.

Thank you for the second reception card and penant. Also for the enclosed stamps.

I am sorry that we do not have QSL cards, but I hope that this do as confirmation of your report. I will enclose with it a picture of the men of the local church carrying in the sections for the towers. That was about 242 years ago when we still had no automobile road here.

Thank you again for your report.
