Dear Sir,

We thank you for your letter dated September 30, 1983, with reception report for Radio 'Frie Sranan' which we appreciate very much.

As you know, an escalation of the brutal military oppression took place in Suriname on December 8, 1982 when at least 15 selected prominent Surinamese citizens were severely tortured and murdered by the military regime in Suriname.

The intention of Radio 'Frie Sranan' is to motivate the Surinamese people, who is suffering under the oppression of the murderous military regime, and to supply them of uncensored news.

Radio 'Frie Sranan' transmits on the frequency of 6850 khz from 01.00 GMT - 01.15 GMT. Our programs are in Dutch, Sranan tongo, Hindustani and Javanese. These are some of the languages and dialects spoken by the inhabitants of Suriname.

In order to inform you as detailed as possible and to enable you to comprehend completely what really is going on in Suriname we are sending you a few documents and some additional information about the developments in Suriname.

We are also sending you an English translation of the book entitled 'De December moorden in Suriname' (The December murders in Suriname), an eye-witness account, which contains crucial details about the horrible events in Suriname on December 8 and 9, 1982.


This book is written by the former Surinamese minister Sariman, who was a good friend of major R. Horb. The regime in Suriname has now officially banned this book by decree and possession of it is punishable.

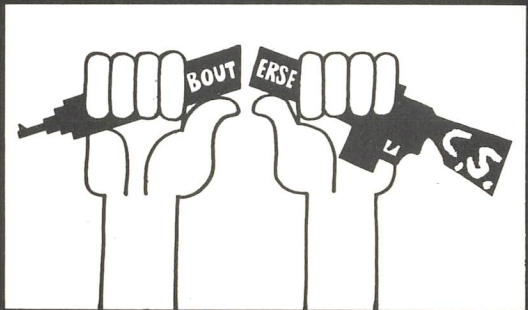
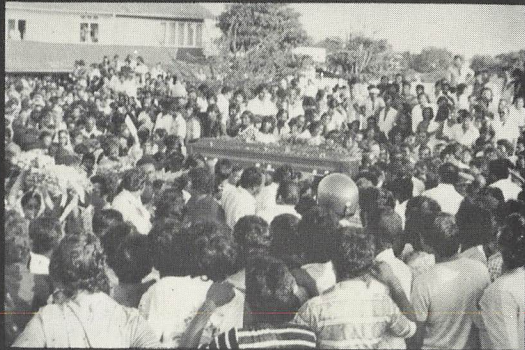
