We are glad to inform you of the receipt of your letter dated June 30, 1970 concerning our broadcast in Vietnamese language of April 18, 1970. Your report exactly corresponds to our characteristics.

We would like to inform you that our French language broadcasts are released every day :

- at 3 hrs (Indochina time) or 20 hrs (GMT) in the 19 and 25 meter-bands (or on 15,050 and 12,000 kilocycles),
- at 5.30 hrs (Indochina time) in the 3I and 4I meter-bands (or on 10,050, 9,920 and 7,400 kilocycles),
- and at 2I hrs (Indochina time) in the 25 and 3I meter-bands (or on 9,920 and 12,000 kilocycles).

Our single broadcast in English (exclusively for GIs in South Viet-Nam) is released every day :

- at 5 hrs (Indochina time) in the 3I and 4I meter-bands (or on 10,050, 9,920 and 7,400 kilocycles),
- and at 2I.30 hrs (Indochina time) in the 25 and 3I meter-bands (or on 9,920 and 12,000 kilocycles).

We would be very grateful to you for following our broadcasts and introducing them to your friends and acquaintances and for letting us know your views and suggestions.
