Dear Mr. Dexter,

Warmest greetings from all of us at Radio Bahá'í, especially Ralph Dexter. He recalls having talked with you some time back and sends his best regards.

Yes, you are quite right that the cassette tape which you sent of Radio Bahá'í's signal is quite poor, and we have had a great deal of trouble identifying it. We are able, however, to confirm your report of reception on 9 January from 0315 to 0333 hours, GMT on 2340 kHz in the 120 meter band.

Your report does coincide with that of Mr. John Tuchscherer of Neenah, Wisconsin who logged us on that same evening.


The reason that you have not received a QSL card from Radio Turismo is that station closed its doors and went off the air some three years ago. The station has relocated in Esmeraldas, Ecuador, operating on the same frequency as before, but we do not have its address at hand.

Speaking of QSL cards, we apologize that ours is not ready yet, but we will send it to you when it is available.

Perhaps you will have the chance to log Radio Bahá'í again. Our new schedule, launched on December 19, is as follows: Daily, except Sundays, from 2400 to 0400 GMT. Our transmission power is 1 kilowatt.

Thank you very much for your report and for the kind wishes regarding our success on short wave.
