inhabitants.

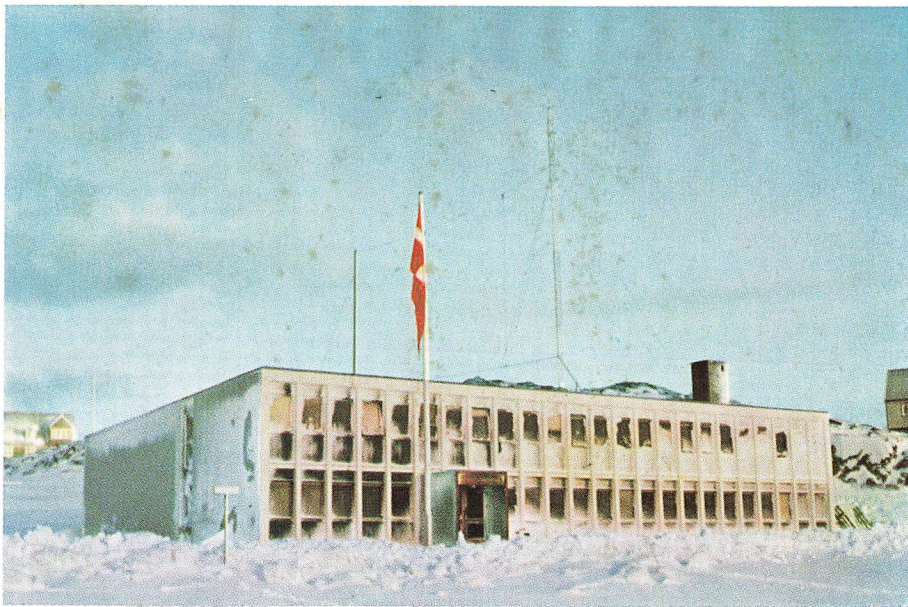
RADIO GREENLAND

Shortwave: (occasionally). **5960 and**

5980 kc/s, both 1kW.
