Dear Sir,

I'm very glad to receive your letter. Your report of our station is very useful and I thank you so much you've enclosing beautiful postage stamps, a picture of your self and a postal view, so I get an idea of what the beautiful part of your home town looks like.

Your reception of our station is correct.

You've heard our station* at 11.57 to 12.17 GMT, this would mean at 20.57 Indonesian Eastern Time, *on September 21, 1971.

You've noted that at 12.00 o'clock at that time, you heard an another man announcer, ~~who~~ a News announcement. That is correct too, because daily at 12.00 GMT or 21.00 Ind.E.Time (West Irian Time) we ~~switch~~ switch on the Broadcast of R.R.I. Djakarta as our head-quarter, to releas the World News or National News.

The output power of our transmitter is only 500 watt. I'm surprised that you've heard and observed our station with fair strength of our signals. So I'm sure, that it is not our transmitter ~~with~~ wich has the strength of the power, but your receiver is the selective of the good one.

Our Transmitter type is Redifon 0,5 kw, and it is now out of date allready. We use antennas with Delta system about 18 meter high, facing east and west.

I'm be very very glad and grateful if you would continued your letter and I hope that ~~our~~ ~~program~~ ~~mes~~ would enjoy you.

I hope good luck and best wishes to you and your staff.
