Dear Sir,

I am very pleased of receiving your letter of October 12th, 1973. Your last letter was of January 21st, 1973 reporting reception of RRI Palembang, operating on 4855 KHz or 61,79 metres. I sent my reply on February 21st, 1973 from Ujung-Pandang. Did you receive it?

Well, many thanks to your report. We have checked it against our station log and we are happy to inform you, that it corresponds wholly with our programmes.

Until now we have been receiving letters from various parts of the world such as Sweden, Finland, Canada, Germany, Italy, Japan, Australia, New Zealand and last but not least the United States of America.

What you listened to was an outlet of our 20 Kilowatt GATES KH-20B transmitter, operating on 5055 KHz (and not on 5054 KHz as you mentioned in your report) or 59,34 metres (and not 59,36 metres). This transmitter is linked with a folded dipole antenne, stretched from 310° West to 130° East. Operational time schedules of this frequency are: 22.00-00.30 GMT and 09.00-15.15 GMT.

We have also a more powerful transmitter, the 50 Kilowatt - PHILIPS 8FZ514, operating on 4720 KHz or 63,56 metres. This frequency operates from 12.30-15.15 GMT. In the last two months we got many letters reporting reception of this frequency. Have you ever listened to it? We would be very pleased if you could spend your spare time to listen to our programs through this frequency.

Enclosed is a postcard, picturing our Nusantara I studio at Ujung Pandang.
