Thank you for your report. This confirms that you were listening to Radio Central on kilohertz at hours G.M.T. on.....^{4/9/76}
Hiri Motu is the main language broadcast over Radio Central. Many Province stations also use local vernaculars to reach their listeners.

Because Papua New Guinea is both tropical and very mountainous (the highest mountain, MT. WILHELM is about 5,000m), and has more than 200 islands within its boundaries.

Radio Central Province is one of the network of over 20 National and Province Broadcasting Stations, controlled by the National Broadcasting Commission of Papua New Guinea, and all announcing and presentation is done by Papua New Guineans.
