Thank you for your reception report which is hereby verified.

Radio Southern Highlands "Nek Bilong Muruk" (Voice of the Cassowary) operates on a frequency of 3,275 kiloHertz in the 90 metre band. The hours of broadcast are 1645 - 2200 AET in the evenings and 5.30 - 8.00 in the mornings.

Radio Southern Highlands is part of the National network of stations owned and operated by the National Broadcasting Commission of Papua New Guinea.


Yours is the second report we have received from the United States. The first report came from Mr. William Sparks of Carlifornia.

Most of our stations in the network use 2kw transmitters except four of the stations which use 10kw transmitters.
