VL8BK RADIO KEREMA - Frequency 3245 Kcs. - 90 metre band. Power 250 Watts. Broadcasts 5.20 p.m. to 9 p.m. daily. Address: Radio Kerema Gulf District, Papua.

VL8BD RADIO DARU - Frequency 3304 Kcs. - 90 metre band. Power 250 Watts. Broadcasts 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. daily. Address: Radio Daru, Western District, Papua.

KEREMA (Languages: Toaripi, Orokolo, English, Police Motu (lingua franca)) serves the people of the Gulf District of Papua. (Population 55,000).

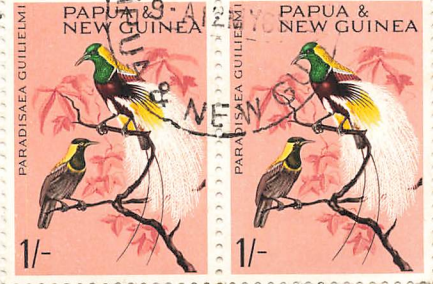
DARU (Languages: Police Motu and English) serves the people of the Western District of Papua. (Population 60,500).
