Dear Gerry,

Thank you very much for your reception report of WTD T's broadcast on 4 December, 1982. You heard WTD T's first transmission, which lasted for approximately one hour that evening.

So far, I have received a total of 7 reception reports, and I'm sure that more are on the way. One was from Kingsport, TN., Wilmington, DE., 3 from NY., one from Florence, SC., and, of course, one from Lake Geneva, WI. In our 2 hour b'dcast tonight, WTD T received two "Loop-Line" phone calls from listeners in Florida, one of whom said WTD T was coming in with a signal over S-9. In tonight's b'dcast, we played music, read reception reports over the air, talked about #'s stations, gave some Air Force One and Two freq.s, and took phone calls (313 9339996)

I hope you heard it. Accessory equip't. used by WTD T includes a Kenwood R-1000, MAX-100 Freq. counter, CBs, scanners, etc.
