ARGENTINA LOL with TC, SS at 2230, on 10000, good lvl behind WV. (Ed Insinger, N.J.)

AFGHANISTAN Radio Afghanistan, 15265, at 1800, gud. lvl with news, music, and ID in EE, though QRM de RM. (Marty Austin, Conn.)...Noted by Albert Miller, Ohio, on 15265, 1800 in EE news, fair lvl.

ALBANIA 7300 RT, world news, 0240; local music by YL. In EE, good lvl. (Joe Helm, Ind.)

ALGERIA Last month's unidentified station on 7220 is Algiers for noted S/off 2355 in // with 11715, 17880. 15160 is another new outlet; noted 2050 in AA; also before 2200 in parallel with 17880. (Victor C. Jaar, Canada)...RTVA noted on 2 new fqys so far.

Both in parallel, in the AA Svc on 17790; being, 11715 and 17880, new. (Steve Estes, Va.)

BOLIVIA 5045.5 R. Altiplano, 0510 in SS, Andean music, an ID. (Ernie Lohe, Va.)

BRAZIL R. Nac Brasilia noted with EE after 2300 on 15445; SS heard after 2345. Annex 9665 and 11720 also. Same outlet noted with PP after 0730 on 6065, 9665. (Victor C. Jaar) ...4995 ZYX2, M&W annex, PP, lots of singing and yelling, IDed several times. (Joe Helm) ...15135 R. Panamericana observed in PP, 0145, with soccer, fair lvl. (S.W. Eichenhorn, Mich.)

CAMBODIA (KR) (FLASH) According to an article in the N.Y. Post of 8/8/73, the Cambodian Communists bombed and occupied Phnom Penh's main International Radio Transmission Station, presumably RDiffusion Nationale Khmère. The 100 Cambodian troops guarding the complex dropped their weapons and fled when fired on by 30 Cambodian Communists. The main bldg was then occupied by the Communists and they blew up several radio rooms inside, injuring 7 Cambodian regulars hiding around the buildings. (Ken Schur, N.Y.)...Larry Magne, Pa., FLASHES that Phnom Penh's "International" SW facilities dynamited out of existence, per the AP, by NUPK guerillas.

CHINA (PR) RP sent beautiful color scene QSL card listing fgy and date on the reverse side. (Ed Insinger, N.J.)

COLOMBIA (FLASH) New HJ outlet being heard nightly on the odd fgy of 3139. Not an image, possibly could be a harmonic. Good lvl by 0400-0500. (Ralphus Perry, Ill.)...A new station is being heard, La Voz de la Cincorder at Cali; it has been heard opening at 1045, closing at 0500 on 3135. (SWCDERS) (See previous FS, Editor)

COSTA RICA R. Reloj, 6006, 1030, native music, all in SS, several IDs. (Joe Helm)

GERMANY (E) 7260 Stimme der DDR, 0320-0335, light music, ID, and TC, in HS. (Ernie Lohe, Va.) ...15240 RBI in GG, 1400*-1445*, with ID. This is a prgm for the NE, South Arabia, and NE Africa at 44444. (Richard Schwartz, Del.)...11700 REX at 1435 in GG with YL and GM reading items. (Albert Miller)

INDIA 15255 AIR, Aligarh, 1320, with DX reports read by both N&W. An ID, at fair to good lvl. (Joe Helm)

GUATEMALA (FLASH) A nice surprise: 4835 Radio Tesulutlan heard on 8/1, 0305 to 0345 E/O, with speeches by two men, good lvl. Possibly only testing, all in SS. (John Tuchscherer,

GUYANA 3290 Action Radio, music, EE, 8/16, 0200, some QRM. (Joe Helm) / Wisc.)

IRAN 9022 R. Teheran, International Svc, 2010-2026 in EE, IS; shortly into Farsi, mostly for Iranians abroad. (Richard Schwartz)

ISRAEL French Prgms are beacst as follows: News in FF, 0515: 9009 and 11960. News in FF, 1200-1230: 11865, 15425, and 17870; French(to Europe?), 2200-2240: 9009, 9625, 9785, 11705, 11960, 15265, and 17765. Some of these outlets are heard in RR after 2100, with most of the jammed. EE beacst noted after 1130 on 15425; 11865 and 17870 could also be used, as heard sometimes. A new outlet is also being used on 10530, as noted with IS at 1950. Also noted with IS just before the 0345 beacst, // 9009. (Victor C. Jaar)...IBA on 11960, 0500-0515*, EE news at great lvl. (Steve Estes, Va.)...IBA, 11960, at 0508, in EE, ending the news; 0515 FF. A new fgy? (S.W. Eichenhorn)...15160 IBA, 1500 in Yiddish, 1530-1615 RR, usually jammed. (Ernie Behr, Canada)

IVORY COAST 11920 This one in FF at 2130-2200 when wiped out by Moscow. (Ed Insinger)

PLEASE TURN OVER

KOREA (N) 11350 Pyongyang still S/on at 1950 but now runs beyond last spring's S/off at 0420...11498 Pyongyang on a new fcy, buried under fifteen layers of utility stations most mornings—heard in S/on at 1300 in CC...12074 Also a new fcy, seemingly a replacement for a lower fcy in the transmission to Europe. S/on at 1600 in KK. (Bill Davis, Cal.)

KIRIBATI KK is using a new fcy, 11735 with AA. S/off after 2100, good lvl. (Victor C. Jaar)

KRANOW 15355 is a new fcy used by Bariut, noted in AA at 0000, SS 0040. (Victor C. Jaar)

LONDON 15350 RL, 1800 all French prgm, past 2200. Vy strong lvl. (Ernie Behr)...EL is back on 15350 in FF prgming, after an absence, possibly S/on is 0500. (Victor C. Jaar)

MEXICO 11820 XEER, Hermosillo at 1450 in SS, ads, pops; at 0300 music, IDs, and ads, past 0530, heard daily since late July, sounds like 5 kv now. (Ernie Behr; Albert Miller)

MADAGASCAR RN Relay, Talata, 15195, 1320-1350, in DD, an ID, news, music. (Richard Schwartz)

NEW CALEDONIA Noumea can be heard quite well after 0530 in FF, noted till 0605 tune out, on 7170. (Victor C. Jaar)

PAKISTAN EE news noted on 17845 at 1300-1310, followed in language; 9645 noted with 11672 during "evenings", weak lvl. (Victor Jaar)

PERU 9520 R. La Cronica noted with music and ID at 0910, SS. (Victor C. Jaar)...This one at 0310 with ads, music, and ID. (Ernie Lohe)...Radio del Pacifico, 11672, at 1702, good in SS, a good ID. (Marty Austin) (11672??, possibly a repeat point, Editor)

REUNION (FLASH) ORTF, St. Denis, sent letter verie for my FF report of June 8th 1973, on 2446. Vy correct in all details. V/S now R. Carrière, Le Chef de Etablissement Technique. Sked also listed. (Ed Insinger) (How about St. Helena, Falkland Is, as your next targets, Edward?? Your Editor)

RUSSIA (TEXT) 3396 Gwelo at 0420 in EE, music, ads, poor to fair lvl. (Albert Miller)

SUDAN 5039 R. Omdurman 0255-0335 in AA, AA songs. (Ernie Lohe)

SWEDEN 17815 Stockholm testing with 500kw; heard in EE anncts at 1130 on 7/18. Good lvl but some QRM from Radio Moscow. (Victor C. Jaar)

SWITZERLAND SBC, Berne, 9535, 0140, with station IS, in EE following, good lvl. (Joe Helm)

SO AFRICA 6000 R. RSA at 2232 in EE, with, "His and Hers" show. (Albert Miller)...3997 Springbok R., Internal Svc, 0500-0515, ID, news, EE. (Richard Schwartz)

TURKEY FF is noted at 2130; EE at 2200 on 11880, from Ankara. (Victor C. Jaar)

URUGUAY R. El Espectador, 11835, at 0037, good lvl in SS. (Marty Austin)

USSR 9375 Khabarovsk with seemingly a new transmitter working, now running from 1800 S/on to 1700 S/off. One of the strongest of the 31 MB Soviet Asian stations...7100 Petropavlovsk-Kamchata, RM, heard in CC from 1400 tune. (Credit both to Bill Davis)...Alma Ata, 9380, 0000 S/on in RR, vy weak but audible, likely IDs as well as bell signal. USB helpful, and SK-100 sensitivity. (Ed Insinger)...RM in African Svc in EE on 15100, at 2040 tuning. QSB high lvl. Asian xmtr?? (Ed Insinger) (Vy possibly an Asian transmitter but schedules and transmitter locations changed possibly at the quarters. Only way to be positive is to QSL asking location of transmitter to be marked in; or possibly by noting ITU listings which are kept up-to-date and reasonably accurate, Editor)

VENEZUELA La Voz del Tigre, 3255, observed at 0245 with LA music, ads, and IDs. (Steve Zaine Verie letter in FF from Mabuma-Bulisi, the "Directeur Technique", of the / Estes) Voix du Zaire, in 19 days, for 3 IRCS. (Marty Austin)

CLANDESTINE: (FLASH) In re the FIAGC operations, the 6240 operation is via an independent transmitter near Conakry. Incidentally, 6240 has replaced 7300 mornings. 2300-2355 is, "Voice of Independent Guinea", per reports from overseas, also a PAIGC operation. A similar operation is aired via Radio Senegal thrice weekly on 764, 4890, and 7170, which may account for the verification from Radio Senegal. (Clandestine Expert Larry Magnus, Pa.) (See previous FS in re this one. Thanks Larry, Editor)...A weak down in the mod station has been heard here several times between 0200-0600, and later on 6255. It is only audible when RNI, 6210 is strong lvl. Hopefully, is Channel Islands Radio. EE smcr with EE accent, and a pop music DJ show heard by Darrell Buxton. Hope this is not a Nibi-Nibi!! (Neal Perdue, Tenn.)

UNIDENTIFIED: 6250 At 2200 to definite 2237 S/off. SS prgm with AA flavor and chanting, rapid IDs in SS. If Eq. Guinea, S/off to early. Fair to poor lvl at best. (Ed Insinger) (Nearly sure to be Eq. Guinea, currently they sign off earlier than listed in WRTH, Editor).
