- AUSTRALIA 5995 1120-1130 in EE with World News. (Jerry Lineback, Ill.) (Radio Australia)
- BOLIVIA 4853 Radio Centenario observed at 2340 in SS. (Ed Shaw, Va.)...4875 La Cruz del Sur, 0155-0205, classical music, an ID, possibly Indian language, too, as fair lvl. (Jerry Lineback)...4912V R. Santa Ana has moved from 9OMB, heard testing here, drifting badly at 0000. (Jack Perolo, Brazil) (Via Don Jensen)
- CAMBODIA(KR) Phnom-Penh, 4907, vy good reception, strong lvl till past 2330. (Jack Perolo)
- CANADA 5130 CHHX Halifax, 2270-2230 EE, DJ, pops, an ID, EE. (Jerry Lineback)
- COLOMBIA Pto Martinez, 5568, QSL via prepared card, power 90 watts, dipole antenna, 15 meters high, 27 meters long. My best LA. (Henderson) QSL letter in from Osvaldo Martinez, 90-100 watts, rt bank Atunato river, 120 km from Quibdo. (Hall) Good daily abt 0215. Stronger than seems possible for reported power. (Shaw) Boos de Pto Martinez varied w/long letter. States population of area only 600; has no pennants or special ode. (Tony James, UK, via Don Jensen) CHINA(PR) ...15500 KP in ES to NA at 0000, on. Fair to good lvl, though noticeably a bit unsteady. (Ed Insinger, N.J.)
- COLOMBIA 5095 R. Sutatenza 0130-0140, woman vocalist in SS, paralleling 5075, but better lvl. (Jerry Lineback)
- DOMINICAN REP 3215 R. Libertad 0350-0400 SS, music, ID, possibly ads. (Jerry Lineback) ...3385 R. Hit Musical 0245-0300 S/off, SS, music, tone on the hour, then left the air, says Jerry Lineback.
- ECUADOR 4790 Sistema de Em Atalaya 0345-0405 SS, sports event, excellent lvl. (Jerry Lineback)
- GUATEMALA 3300 TCNA/C, 0330-0340 EE, religious prgm, talk, best on LSB. (Jerry Lineback)
- ICELAND Reykjavik Radio with test tape in EE and Icelandic, noted at 1840, on 12175. At poor to fair lvl, with USB quite effective. (Ed Insinger)
- INDIA 11710 AIR at 2315-2400 in GOS, EE, news, an interview, M&W annrcs., Indian music, not particularly good lvl. (Jerry Lineback)
- INDONESIA (FLASH) The RRI Network is going to reorganize between 1974 -1979, as all SW stations EXCEPT Foreign Svc, will change to MW. (Larry Yarnon, Pa., via Editor Dan Jamison)...QSL letter in from Usman Abdullah, B.A., for reception of RR Gorontalo, 4900, reports Don Jensen.
- LUXEMBOURG 6090 At 0015, M&W annrcs, music, noted later with EE. Some evenings is good lvl. (Joe Helm, Ind.)
- MOZAMBIQUE (TENT) R. Clube de Mozambique noted 0000 on 7/4. News read by man in PP on 15295, some pops between items. (Joe Helm)
- NEW ZEALAND 9520 Wellington observed at 1130 with world and local news read by a man, followed by comments, an ID. Fair to nice lvl. (Joe Helm)
- SENEGAL 7210 R. Senegal logged 0700-0745 in PF with an ID by OM, news, music, some with EE lyrics. An ID by a YL. 44333 until 0730 fade out. (S.W. Eichenhorn, Mich.)
- PERU 4815 Definitely a Peru outlet, from anthem at closing, but did not get definite ID at 0458 because of poor readability. From 0440 tune till 0500 S/off. (John Tuchscherer)
- PORTUGAL 6153.5 (TENT) R. Renascenca at 0630. Thanks to tips have found carrier//Wisc.) het two mornings and what sounds like man in PP. Overseas tips say the outlet is on the air. (Ed Shaw)
- SWEDEN In a late note from Radio Sweden: "Only one of the planned new three 500kW transmitters is being used. However, it is being used only with reduced power (about 150-200kW)". (Ed Insinger)
- SWAZILAND 6155 Swazi Commercial Radio still heard rather often over Austrian Radio/DW. Last heard 6/3, fair lvl 0430-0500. Received QSL letter from P. O. Box 941, Hhbabane, Swaziland, signed by CE/Station Mgr Stan Cobbi(ham call 3D6AU). He served 10 years with Royal Navy as Signals Officer, so apparently he has a long radio background. Cobbi mentioned the the 100 kW transmitter will be activated in a few months and will operate two SW frequencies simultaneously. (Churchill, Cal., via Don Jensen)

SUDAN 4994 R. Omdurman, 0700 in AA, on 6/23, guitar, AA music, must be a move from higher up the band. (Ed Shaw)

TAIWAN 17720 VOFC at 0310 tuning, at excellent no strain lvl in EE. (Ed Insinger)

TAHITI 11825 Radio Tahiti noted with news and ID at 179, pretty good for me. (Dan Trigilo, Tex.)...15170 Capets, at 0430, news in FF by man and woman, some music between items. Reception vy good lvl. (Joe Helm)...9698 Tahiti noted here 7/11, in FF and good music, parallel 11825, but much weaker, 0500-0700. (Jim Hagen, Va.)

UPPER VOLTA 4813 Ouagadougou at 0615 in FF, vy good lvl, free of QRM/M, man singing with popular music. (Ed Shaw)

USA The Voice of OAS in EE, 2345, 0000 on 11740, news, music about OAS countries. (Ed Insinger)

USSR R. Vilnius, 11770(Sundays), 2230 excellent, in EE. (Ed Insinger)...Minsk (TSVT) 15150 Pops continuous, armed at 1200. Reception good. Heard this one several times, though never in EE on the fgy. (Joe Helm)...Kiev 11900 At 0115 in EE with a talk or, "Life in Sections of USSR". Reception good lvl. (Joe Helm)

VATICAN VR in EE to the USA daily at 0100 for the summer on fgy of: 5995 // 9605 // 11845 (new fgy). Latter is well heard. (Ed Insinger)

VIETNAM(N) Radio Hanoi, 1300 on 10040 in EE, and 1800 on 15010V, in EE. Both vy well heard here on BCNA, best ever. Just good conditions, or a power increase? (Ed Insinger)...15012V Hanoi heard with EE at the new time period of 1800-1828 S/off, pretty fair lvl here in the midwest. (Al Niblack)

KUWAIT (Last minute item) 11735 "Huna Kuwait" good listening lvl 2050-2100 in AA music, several IDs by man amcr. (Al Niblack)

THIS AND THAT: The Voice of Peace Ship for the first time has admitted that there is an amateur station on board, and has been inviting ham-contacts on 40 Meters. (SWDXERS)
