These things usually end with a personal visit by the FCC, and an order to immediately cease and desist, followed by seizure, if not immediately obeyed. On 12/25, AA chanting was observed from 1640 past 1655, which is known to be used by Kuwait at this time. No speech was heard. Faded by 1655, and became weak and wattery. (Editor Bob Hill)...4976 From 1604-1616 Tune out, 12/15, man in dictation type news in EE, a missed ID at 1604. Vy difficult to read because of very strong ute present. (Dave Williams)...15380 1505 An AA spkr with news on 1/1, music 1515, seemed jammed. (Glenn Hauser)

ERRATUM: BRAZIL Info in Mid-December FS for R. Ministerio da Educacao on 9710 was incorrect (yours or mine), should have been 9770. (Bob Zilmer, Wisc.)
LAST MINUTE ITEMS AT DEADLINE TIME: BRAZIL 4995 R. Brasil Central, 2355, PP talk and native music, though poor signal. (Bob Zilmer)...PARAGUAY 6025 Radio Nacional de Paraguay, ID at 0901 on 1/1, into music, man annor, bank ads, all in SS. (Gerry Dexter) ...INDONESIA RRI Jakarta, 3277, II songs 1540; weak, but definitely not Radio Kashmir (which I wanted and was hoping for). (Bill Sparks, Calif.)...VENEZUELA 4917 R. Dif. Venezuela heard 12/12, 13, 14, in a move from 4890, usual fqy, around 0200; have since moved back to regular fqy 4890. They tend to make this change every year at this time. (Alan Roth via NU) (Ernie Behr, this is very probably your unidentified Venezuelan outlet that you reported to the January 1975 FS, Editor)

ANGOLA 4886 (TENT) Possibly Teixeira da Sousa in Afro music, Chimes, PP by OM, at 2156, on 12/26. (Al Miller, Ohio)...5050 R. Clube de Cabinda, 2115, 12/30, local pops, maybe singing ads, all PP. (Al Miller)(In MM December FS an item in re R. Clube de Cabinda**, stated, 1900, that this one was using an experimental fqy of 4970; possibly, move was only temporary, Editor)...7245 Emissora Nacional from 0610, 1/6, with cmtry re African matters in PP (and occasional EE), to 0628, then a vocal, considerable QRM de RFE; clear ID, "Emissora Nacional" by man in PP at 0634. (Hadley Cress, Va.) (Has this one changed their ID from previous, Emissora Oficial?, Editor)

AUSTRALIA As annod fqy on RA following the Darwin disaster, the local station "8DR", whose studio survived but transmitting capability was eliminated, was relayed on SW via Shepparton, with the audio fed via microwave. Schedule: 0000-1000, 17715; 1010-1730, 9550; and 1800-2350, on 11810. (Glenn Hauser, Okla.)

BRAZIL 3295 R. Educ. de Uberlandia, 0840-0850, with accordion instrumentals, a few ballads, and an 0845 definite ID, on 1/3. (Dan Sheedy, Calif.)

CANADA(?) 11710 BRC WS Relay in EE, special 12/25 only, for Queen's message; phase close to 9555, but long delay after message on 6195, to 0945*. Either Sackville or VOA site, judging from the sound of it.

CHAD Ndjamana, 4904.5M, 2239-2245, FF, Xmas music, an ID, cmtry. (Richard Schwartz, Del.)

CHINA(PR) 4915 Nanning, Kwangsi, noted 1330 in CC for Kwangsi PES, then continued with EE spelling lessons. (To clear up confusion regarding the two Chinese Beasters in this segment of the band: 4915 is Nanning (per Japanese monitors) and is dual 8759V (Peihai); 4925 is Harbin and is dual 5950. (Editor Bob Hill)...10173 China News Broadcasting Station, Peking; at 1605 tune, dictation news in CC read by woman, phenomenal signal. (Editor ...5860 2300 Bob Zilmer's unID is Peking, 12/27, fade in, at 2255, with w- / Bob Hill) man in talk; at 2259 TS of 6 spaced tones, last higher, "CJKT" ID. (Glenn Hauser) (Glenn further ads that he should have said China HS, not necessarily Peking, Editor)

COLOMBIA 3660 R. Cordobesa (not only 1220x2), but 1220x3, with SS annot at 1043. Weaker here, but clearer than 2440, due less noise. (Glenn Hauser)

CONGO 4765 RTC, Brazzaville, from 0510, woman in vernacular (likely news), 0517 mention of Brazzaville, parallel 6115; clear, solid signal, 12/24. (Editor Bob Hill)

KOREA(N) 2850 Pyongyang HS already in at 0903, but weak lvl. (Glenn Hauser) (Pardon, I listed this one out of alphabetical order, Editor)

COSTA RICA 4832 (See previous FS) In regard to my Mid-December item concerning EE on Radio Capital, I recently noted an article in the December 30, 1974, issue of Newsweek, on Page 24. The article dealt with "Vesco Vezeation". Robert Vesco is a financier and is said to, "Own or control at least one television station and a handful of radio stations...." After reading the article in Newsweek I have come to the conclusion that the man speaking in EE over Radio Capital may have been Robert Vesco, or a representative of his, explaining his (Robert Vesco's viewpoint politically), and why he could not return to the United States. The preceding is my own belief on the EE broadcast that I heard. It may, or may not be true. (Mike Peraaho, Minn.)

DOMINICAN REP 11700 Radio Clarin noted 1/4, 0005-0205, with baseball boast, cms for Pepsi-Cola, at strong lvl, on new fqy. (Bill Stevens, Pa.)

ETHIOPIA 11830 EFLF noted from 2015, 1/6, with religious talk in EE, then annod daily schedule, followed by woman annor. Complete ID in EE, off at 2028, was operating on a recently new fqy. (Hadley Cress)

GALAPAGOS IS 4810 As Ernie Behr says, R. LV de Galapagos suffers less QRM at this hour, 1237, for noted 1/4, with a SS ID, Andean music, lvl poor to fair. (Glenn Hauser)

GERMANY(D.R.) 11700/15240 RRI noted in GG for ME, 1400-1445*, "Berliner Festage", music by DDR composer Kurt Schrumm, fair lvl. (Richard Schwartz)

GUYANA 5950 Action Radio in the clear 12/23, 0015, in EE, on this rarely reported fqy, as the Colombian-5951, seemed to be missing. Also on at 0946 when rechecked. (Glenn Hauser)

**More on R. Clube de Cabinda: In January 1975 FS, the outlet is reported moved to 4860 (formerly 5053). Suggest info be listed tentative, pending more checks, Editor)

GUATEMALA 4835 Radio Tesulutlan noted in SS, with Maximba music, 1/4, few anncts. (Al Miller)...4835 R. Tesulutlan noted 12/23, before 0100, in SS, talks, Maximba, with stronger signal than R. Capital-4832, but weaker modulation. (Glenn Hauser)...2200 R. Superior, 0600 in SS, on long after listed S/off, an ID 0559, 1,100 kc, and CST TCs, ads. (Glenn Hauser)(2x100)

GUINEA (Eq) Santa Isabel is now Malabo; and, the station is R. Malabo. (Serge Neumann via NU)...6250 (TENT) Radio Santa Isabel, 2230-2249*, in continuous Afro music, suddenly into NA and off, no annct. (Editor Jerry Lineback)...Note, after this one S/off, an unidentified, noted on 6250, weak lvl, in language talk, and Afro music! Who?? (Editor Jerry Lineback) (Possibly the Clandestine FP and vernacular splkr that was previously on 6240?, Editor)...4926 Bata 2207-2220, Afro music, on late New Year's eve (Editor Jerry Lineback)

GUINEA (REP) 4910 (TENT) R. Dif. Nacional 0515-0532 in language, OM talking, / Lineback) poor lvl, 12/31. (Editor Jerry Lineback, Ill.)

LIBERIA 3227 EIMA noted 2120 with Afro music and chanting, vernacular language. (Al Miller)

MALAYSIA 6080 BCFES, Tebrau, observed at 2320 in II, seemingly news of that country, via long-path. (Editor Bob Hill)

MAURITANIA 4845 (TENT) Radio Mauritania heard from 2050 with vocals of Afro-Arabic nature; Probable ID at 2119, though not clear. (Hadley Cress)

NEW HEBRIDES 3945 Radio Vila from 0843, man and woman in FF—copy too poor to tell whether discussion or news. Off at 0919:55. Carrier lvl quite good throughout, but modulation weak, audio vry difficult copy. (Editor Bob Hill) (Bob has another "most wanted", Editor)

NEW CALEDONIA 3355 ORTF, Noumea, from 0840, woman in FF, as if in some kind of speech, quite good lvl, but usual severe RTTY QRM from 3356.5, 12/28. (Editor Bob Hill)

NEPAL 3425 Radio Nepal noted 1240-1300 in language, local music, talks, anncts by woman, fair, heard nearly daily, but no positive ID because of weak lvl. Is it Nepal?? (Editor Jerry Lineback)...Radio Nepal, 3425, noted several mornings, including 12/28, just after listed 1150 S/on. Often, at good strength. (Gerry Dexter, Wisc.)...3425 (TENT) Radio Nepal noted in native, with group singing, oriental music, 1240, 12/27. (Al Miller)...Got something on 3425; Nepal now a regular here starting 1145 S/on, good through 1210 hours, QSB, and voice just not quite readable. (George Schnabel, N.Y.)

NICARAGUA 2930 R. Ecos de las Brumas, nominally 1460, formerly 1454.5, as revealed by harmonic on 2909, now must be on 1465 (though not heard there), for noted 1/1, 0215 LA music, TC, an ID in SS, poor lvl. (Glenn Hauser) (2x1465)

NIGERIA 6090 RTV, Kaduna, at 2300, news in EE; 2305, news in Hausa; 2308 chanting, 2316 annct, 2317 NA and off. (Editor Bob Hill)

VIETNAM (N) 6380 Once and for all, the station currently heard here around 1100-1630 or so, is Fay Bac, not Ulan Bator. Fgy varies 6385 to 6382 more or less. Watch for the sing-song Vietnamese talk. Considerably different from the more emphatic, strident Chinese, and not at all like Mongolian, which is not a tonal language, but more like the central USSR tongues. (Editor Bob Hill) (Amen, Editor)...7290 On 12/25, Hanoi was here at 1705 in VV parallel 10040V. It is a new fgy...10041V On 12/24, Hanoi was heard here at 1210 with a beat in SS, not listed language for this station in WRTH. Solid copy. (Credit both items to Editor Bob Hill)

PAKISTAN 5018V RP 0137-0207 fade out, 12/26, talk in language by OM, much mention of Pakistan, an ID by YL, parallels 7095. (Dave Williams, Ore.)

PHILIPPINES According to official information from the FEBC, the Far East Broadcasting Co., is erecting a new MW station at Iba, Zambales, No. Luzon, for boasts to Hong Kong, S. China, and S.E. Asia, completion around April 1975, with 250KW output on 1470 khz, MW, call sign DZHP. (SWDXERS)

PERU 5026 Radio Quillabamba from 2306, 12/24, with talk in SS, music, an ID at 2310. Note: This is what I get when I check for Uganda, 5026! (Hadley Cress) (Don't feel like the lone Indian, Hadley, I checked for 30 years before I logged Kampala, and got an acknowledgment card, Editor)

PAPUA/NG From the listing of the Finnish bulletin Sunspot, the following information is noted: (for the P/NG stns)...3245 now called Radio Gulf; 3260 now Radio Madang District; 3385 now Radio East New Britain; 3336 now Radio East Sepik. (Gerry Dexter via NU)...3245 Kerema, 1320 vernacular, EE C&W music, poor lvl...3305 R. Western District, 1325, vernacular, vocals...2468 R. Northern District, 1330 vernacular, language vocals. Was a good morning for P/NG outlets. (Credit all to Editor Jerry Lineback)...Radio Hahual (now Radio East New Britain, according to latest info, Editor), vry good signal, news in Pidgin. So. Sea Island music, from 1230. (George Schnabel)(3385)

PAPUA/NG (Continued from preceding page) 3220 Radio Morobe, 1240, in Pidgin, South Sea and C&W music, 1/1, at fair lvl. (Al Miller)

SAO TOME (FLASH) 5338 Noted 1/1/75, Emissor Regional with almost continuous music, pop vocal and instrumental, PP anncts, through 2350; PP ID at 2337, on new fgy. Thanks to Larry Magne for this one. (Dave Williams)...5338.3 (FLASH) Emissor Regional on new fgy, probably ex-4807, noted in PP, 12/27, 0602; Again, 12/29, 2300 tune in, vry good, US pops. On 12/28, was missing, though seems fairly regular. (Glenn Hauser)

SINGAPORE 7239V R. Singapore on 12/24 only, this outlet noted here from 7250, at 1420 in Malay. Dual 6155, partly audible through PEN. On 12/31, however, was back on 7250 at 0930, very fine signal. (Editor Bob Hill)

SWAZILAND Swazi Music Radio, 4980, a regular here after Ecos del Torbes S/off. IDs as, "More Music-SMR". Usually gone by 0430 fade out. (C. Brandon Lovett, Ohio)...3223 Swazi Music Radio also noted on this fgy, 2144-2200*, in EE, pops, ads and singing cms, on 12/30, nice. (Al Miller)...4980 Swazi Music Radio noted on various checks 1600-1700, Hit Parade Top 20; IDs as, "SMR". At first thought that it was SABC or Mozambique. Same general format, and SMR's quick IDs hard to pick up. Good signal now for Long-Path. (Dave Williams)...TWR, Radio Swaziland, 7135, 0357-0359, 12/29, with definite ID, religious program. I got a tape and am delighted to document my first reception of Radio Swaziland. (Richard Schwartz)

SWEDEN The Swedish Broadcasting Corp., will celebrate its 50th Anniversary on Jan 1, 1975. The Swedish Postal Board will issue commemorative stamps. An enlargement of one of the stamps will be used by Radio Sweden for a special verification card, to be used for verifying reception reports from Jan. 1, 1975, onwards. The first transmission you may report in order to get this special QSL card is our New Year's greeting on New Year's Eve, when it midnight here in Sweden. (SWDXERS) (Our sincere congratulations to Radio Sweden and its personnel, we wish them long and continued success in their broadcasting endeavors, Editor)

TURKS IS 4788 VSB seldom makes it this far west, and this is my first definite log on them; 1/4, 2229 BFC news theme, delayed relay. Local numbling DJ at 2239, poorly modulated. An ID as, "Radio 4788". Also heard TCs and VSI Pop Parade. Off at 0026. (Glenn Hauser)

THAILAND 9654 NBS, Bangkok, at 1045 tune, news in EE (mostly about Asia) by woman with accent, 1054 ID for R. Thailand, 1100 pop vocal. 1128 recheck, Thai vocal parallel 715.5. No sign of 11905 which has been unreported in quite a while, I believe. (Editor Bob Hill)...7108A (TENT) R. Thailand from 1311-1315* with So. Sea music, anncts by a woman and a man. (Editor Neal Perdus, Tenn.)

TOGO 6155 R. Dif Togo, Lama Kara, weak, heavily QRM'd at 0528 S/on with IS, anthem, annct by man in FF. Parallel to 5047. (Gerry Dexter)

UPPER VOLTA Ouagadougou, 2239, FF, ID, cmtry, news, mentioned Volta's participation in Pan-African Conference, fair lvl. (Richard Schwartz)(4815)...Ouagadougou from 0631, 12/21, with man in FF, seemingly news to 0642, followed by IS for 15 seconds, on 4815, signal fair to good. (Hadley Cress)

USSR 4010 Frunze, KIRGHIZ SSR, from 0147 with modulation but unreadable; 0158 silense, 0159 an IS, then anncts by man and woman, weak and fluttery. (Editor Bob Hill, Calif.)...4545 Alma Ata, KAZAKH SSR, at 0210 man and woman in RR, probably with news from Moscow; seemed //10530, not parallel 9520; and, 5260 was unreadable because of fax QRM, 12/31. (Editor Bob Hill)...7300 (TENT) R. Dushanbe, TADZHIK S.S.R., at 1400, in language S/on, possibly the news read by a man, local ARQ QRM. (Al Miller)

ZAMBIA 4950 R2 heard on various checks since 12/4, good this date, 1633-1700, mostly pops music, ES anncts, TCs. At first, thought was Kenya. Good for Long-Path. (Dave Williams) (Dave, is this really Zambia, Editor.)

ZANZIBAR 3339 RTZ, 0332 indistinct talk, 0339 Afro music; 0359, 5 pip TS, 0400 an ID—, drum IS, Habari news. (Glenn Hauser)

HARMONIC LISTENING: COLOMBIA 2860 Proving the value of harmonic DXing is this item (per Glenn): A station last known to be under construction, per WRTH info released last May was KJ10, 1 kW, Brisas del Cauca, Cauca, Antioquia. Thanks to the excellent harmonic from 1430 it was radiating all-night Xmas, we know its now on the air, heard from 0820 in SS(2x1430). (Glenn Hauser)

CLANDESTINES (FLASH) Noted on 1/2, a station anncing as, "KHRS, St. Louis, Mo., 4700 khz", heard from 0341-0345* in EE, pops, at S/off giving power as 25 watts to a $\frac{1}{2}$ wave vertical, TC for CST, weather as 32 degrees, 4.7 mhz, on your shortwave dial.
