(Charles Wootten)... Just in, printed QSL card, jungle scene, from Emissor Regional de Sao Tome, for 5338. V/S semi-legible, but last name looks like Rei. Mentioned in EE that next fgy to be used on shortwave will be 4807. (Ralph Perry, Ill., via NU)...(Sigh, me, I don't have a QSL from Sao Tome, for my report, Editor)...Cape Verdes will celebrate Independence on July 5, as will Sao Tome on July 12. AUSTRALIA 15290 RA, 0400, African Svc, EE news, fair signals on 7/6. (Bob Zilmer)

AUSTRIA The Austrian Army Station on 6255, Der Schulungssender des Osterreichischen Bundeswehres, Gussriegelstr. 45, A-1002, Vienna, is on the air Mon-Fri 1000-1400; and, 1530-1900. (SWCDXERS)

BRAZIL (See previous FS) The Brazilian noted by you (AL Niblack) and Editor Bob Hill on 4985.5, is heard almost nightly from 0300 fade-in; I have heard several IDs for, "Radio Brasil Central", though modulation is often low. (Tom Alleman)...4985A This one is Radio Brasil Central in a move from 4995, noted with PP ID at 0200, upon rechecks, now that QRN lvl is down, is not Voz de Oeste. Tom, you are entirely correct. (AL Niblack) ...Hello DXers Prgm from HCJB reports that R. Nacional de Brasilia has only one 250kW transmitter in operation, and that beamed to Europe only. Second transmitter is being shipped from Switzerland and will be used to cover No. America. Antennas are in for this transmitter. (Bob Zilmer)

BHUTAN The National Youth Assc of Bhutan runs Radio NYAB which began beasting officially on 11/11/1974, the King's Birthday. Transmissions are on Sundays only at 0730-0930, with EE and Bhutanese, and music prgming format. (NZDX Times) (7040)

CHINA (PR) RP, 9390, 0142-0154, an ID, report on grain production, S'off. (Ben Carter)

CHILE 9590 R. Pres Balmaceda ID, ads, gongs, 6/27, at 1732. (Glenn Hauser)

COLOMBIA 5035A Listened to a Colombian 6/29, 0500-0630, I never did get an ID except that it was an RCN network station. SS, LA music, suspect Voz de Caqueta. (Henry Lazarus)

EGYPT (UAR) (See previous FS) 15335 Radio Cairo on new fgy in EE, 0200, IS and ID. This was my previous unidentified with native African prgming. (Bob Zilmer)...17725 Radio Cairo from tuning 1515-1859*, in EE prgm, "Voice of Africa". Good clean signal. (Hadley Cress)...Radio Cairo, 9475, 0200-0215 gal anncr with letters prgm, AA music, vy good lvl. (Ben Carter)

ETHIOPIA 7165 ETLF at 0359, EE, IS, an ID, then jammed, on 7/5. (Bob Zilmer)

FINLAND 15185 R. Finland, at 2300, EE ID only, annod not temporarily using EE. (Bob Zilmer)

GAMBIA 4820 Gambia noted here from 0615-0715 in language with Afro music and chants. Into EE BBC news 0700. Good sigs for 3kW. Is my 100th HIC in 8 months of DXing. (John Moritz, Jr.)

GERMANY (E) 9620 RBI at 0143 with political cmtry, on new, unlisted fgy, SS. (Jack Jones)

GREENLAND Godthaab can occasionally be heard on 9575 around 2200, though reception is rather poor, fgy generally covered by RAI. IS, though weak, once heard between 2210-2215. (Victor C. Jaar)

GUINEA REP LV du Revolution has been logged here on 11965, fading in after 0300, with non stop music, until 0330, when heard with an ID in FF. (Tom Alleman)

HUNGARY 15220 Radio Budapest finally audible here 6/28, 0359 with IS, but no trace on 17710. In a recent DX prgm R. Budapest said these channels were 1 or 2kW xmtrs, being used for, "modulation experiments". (Glenn Hauser) (DXers, heres your chance to get a low power station from Europe, lower your QRP, Editor)

INDIA 17705 AIR poking across the pole 6/24, 0356, in Hindi talk. (Glenn Hauser)
