GUATEMALA 4825 Radio Mam noted 0111 in SS, several IDs, marimba music. (Jack Jones)

INDIA AIR, Delhi, 9912, at 2027 in EE talk, usually good lvl when ute gone. (Mike Agner)

INDONESIA 4650 RPKDK, Simalungun, SUMATRA, from 1340 tuning. Woman with dictation speed II, lost by 1405. This is a new one for me, makes me happy! (Ed Shaw)...11790 VOI good lvl at 1115, with news read in EE. (Glenn Hauser)

IRAN 15084 Radio Iran with Farsi chants, anncts by man, often good lvl. (Mike Agner)

KENYA Did I tell you that I finally QSLed this one after 3 years, an ECNA catch on 4915. This confirmation pleases me v'y much! (Ed Shaw)

KOREA(N) Radio Pyongyang is on 9370 with EE; this is correct as I reported in May FS; also heard on 9340 at 1000-1052 in EE. (Bob Zilmer) (Thanks for the confirmation, Editor) ...9977 KCBS in EE at 1845, commenting on the future of Korea, on 6/3...12070 Radio Pyongyang and Radio Moscow QRMing each other here, 5/24, 0400, Korea in SS; RM in EE. MEXICO 9609.45 Noted R. Universidad Nacional reactivated on 5/23, with ID and fqys, at 1659, in SS; is XEYU, unheard since last November when was on 9767.2. (Glenn Hauser)

MADAGASCAR After many months received a QSL for my report to Madagascar RT-Malagasy, 17730, which I am happy to have, though long ago I QSLed RNB M Relay. (Ed Insinger)

MALTA 11865 DW Relay at 0140 in EE News, ID at 0150 as Malta. (Jack Jones)

MARTINIQUE 5995 Thanks to Hadley Cress and his reports in FS, was able to log Fort-de-France from 0210 in FF with a wide variety of music, and a gal with an ID at 0245. Reception poor at beginning but progressively better. My country #96. (John Moritz, Jr.)

NEW CALEDONIA 11710/7170 Radio Noumea from tuning at 0508, with old U.S. pops, FF anncts, not robust lvl, but good modulation. Earliest hour ever heard here. (Hadley Cress).

NEW ZEALAND (Please see previous FSs) In reply to my question (Editor), whether Radio New Zealand used the fqy of 17900 as shown in their schedule sent to a No. American listener and then published in the FS, the following reply dated May 19, 1975 was received: (quote) "I am afraid the entry on the schedule should have read 11900 Mhz, not 17900 Mhz, used in recent times". PAKISTAN 15323.5 Radio Pakistan on 5/31, at 0335 music, Swahili, in //17830, seemingly down in fqy, from my last report. (Glenn Hauser)...11672 Radio Pakistan from tuning at 1837, 6/3. String instrumentals, short vocals; anncts and an ID at 1859, in presumed Urdu, fair lvl. (Hadley Cress)

PERU Radio America, Lima, 9505, QSLed in 55 days with an attractive pix postal card, and complete data SS letter. V/S: Angelica Montoya C, Departamento de Publicidad.

PHILIPPINES 11855 FEBC in EE at 1115, giving QTH. This fgy sked from 0800-1245 with a beam centered on the USA. (Glenn Hauser)

SOLOMON IS 5015 SIBS is indeed using this fgy for noted 0950-1000 with folk and islands music, anncr in EE, BBC news 1001-1015, ID by man at 1015, followed by music request prgm DJed by man in EE/Pidgin at 1016. Poor lvl at first, but improved to good lvl later. (Dan Shingler)

TAHITI Radio Tahiti, 15170, heard briefly on 5/23, at about 1045, with EE newscast. (Henry

TAIWAN 15125 BCC observed 0305 with EE news about Taipei, with SINPO 24333 / Lazarus) until interrupted by strong QRMer, maybe XEROX? (Glenn Hauser)

TURKS IS VS18 sent a folder on their operation, information as follows: On 4788, 1:00 to 2:30 PM; and 5:00 to 6:00 PM, Monday through Fridays...1:00 to 3:00 PM; and 5:00 to 6:30 PM Saturdays, all local times. (Grady Ferguson)

THAILAND 6045 Or Sor (Amphorn Sathan), Royal Household Broadcasting Stn, finally verified by ppd card for 1971 rept. Power listed as 1000 watts. V/S difficult to read but seems to be K. Vajardouy, or similiar. (Don Jensen)

USSR 9840 Radio Baku, AZERBAIJAN SSR, noted with best opening reception on 5/31, with IS of chimes vly clear, from 0157 plus (dissimiliar from RM); at just prior to 0200 woman anncr gave ID and I am sure of word, "Baku". Upon another check from tuning 0205, with man and woman anncrs alternating till 0212, a pause, then into native or similiar music till 0245; then began piano music, seemingly setting-up exercises, to 0257, when pause followed by IS. Lotsa QRM on and near the spot. Receivable only on LSB. My country #127. (Hadley Cress)...7135 Mrs. Stepanova QSLed this fgy at 0300 in SS to Central America, with the transmitter site marked in as Dushanbe (TADZHIK SSR), with what I judge as a new series and very attractive QSL card. (AL Niblack)...15150 Minsk (so listed in WRTH) with RR talk by woman IS and an ID at 1730. Believe this is Moscow HS 1 prgm. (Mike Agner)(As I recall, this fgy was QSLed by Mrs. S several years ago for a relay with the transmitter site, as Minsk; but, changes are so rapid and numerous with RM that one usually can't be positive about a site until QSLed, Editor)...7310 Irkutsk(?), RSFSR ASIATIC, Mayak, 6/3, 1856, Russian opera...7320 Magadan, RSFSR ASIATIC, 6/3, Mayak, /76080, 7200, 7210, 9770, but at 1900 split into first prgm. (Credit both to Glenn Hauser)

VENEZUELA 5049 Radio Mundial from 0325 tuning with native music, SS ID at 0346. First time logged here. (Hadley Cress)

YEMEN 9575 Radio Sanaa heard several times before listed S/on of 0330, IS of flute (or similiar), different from the one heard before, but ID positive. (Ed Shaw)

ZAIRE 15350 (TENT) Heard every day in FF and vernacular, with talks and Afro music, but unable to pick out a positive ID. Sounds like Kinshasa. Any info?? (Bob Zilmer)(See an earlier FS, Editor)

LAST MINUTE ITEMS ISRAEL As a neighborly gesture, IBA has moved from two channels that were mixing with other bcasters, viz. *2200-2255* 9605 FF has been moved to 9560, to free the channel for Sweden; and, *0700-2205* HH HS on 15535 has been moved to 15512, to free the channel for Bangui. (Larry Magne)...15512 IBA HS on new fgy, 6/5, 1713 in Ladino, 1715 TS, into Georgian; better than 15485 at this hour. (Glenn Hauser)

MONGOLIA 11810 At 2200 Radio Ulan Bator in EE with an ID, news, music, talks, station QTH at 2228, S/off at 2230. (John Mainland via NZDX Times)

CLANDESTINES 10100v Radio Espana Independiente noted at 1722 with talk in SS by man, at fair lvl over jamming. (Mike Agner)...Japan's Isao Ugusa reports that the Sihanouk VNUFK station is now off the air, apparently for good. This used to be heard in Pa., on 10080, 9988v, 12006, and 7016v. (Larry Magne)
