BHUTAN Dropped a note to Bhutan for current information on Radio NYAB and received a nice letter in return from secretary Louise Dorji who says that the current schedule as of 25 Jan 1983 is Sundays on 7040 from 0600-0900. On Wednesdays and Fridays on 4690 from 1100-1400. Also says, "At present we are operating with 300 watts powered (sic) transmitter. We do not as yet have any definite plan to increase the power or schedule. (John Moritz, OH)

BRAZIL R. San Carlos, 2420, tentative in PT 2327-47; believed the one here in bad noise with ballad type tunes and bossa nova stuff. Booming M annr w/ reverb 2329 w/ ID, but missed it. W on tape at times. Signal good enough but noise terrible. (Moritz, OH 1-29) +++ R. Cl. Marilla, 3235, in PT 2348-0002 booming in at almost 20 db over 9. Song at t/in called "Brasilia, Brasilia" or something similar. Into ranchera type song then folkish tune. M w/ Radio Clube at 2357. At 0000 into William Tell Overture w/ M talking over it and ID by him then. (Moritz, OH 1-29) +++ R. Borborema, 5025, in PT 0137-0203; M annr between catchy "beat" vocals by W. ID by him 0157 w/ MW freq noted and some ads. (Moritz, OH 2-4) +++ R. Aparecida, 5035, in PT 0005 w/ religious broadcast. (Marlin Field, MI 1-13)

BURMA BBS, 4725, presumed in lang 1240-1300. Pgm of Asiatic mx w/ brief annmets by W on 1-28. Noted again on 1-30 1230-1315 also presumed w/ a number of talk pgms in lang to 1259, interval signal, possibly of cymbals, at 1259 followed by 15 minutes of talk by W to fade out. (Henry Lazarus, LA 1-30)

CAMEROUN R. Buea, 3970, tentative in FR 0555-0605; thought the one here w/ M annr mixing w/ BBC in EG. Covered by QRM at t/out. (Moritz, OH 1-22)

CENT. AFR. REP. LV de Rep. Centrafricaine, 5035, in FR 2100-2200+; poor. Fading in and out w/ jazz mx, long talk and drama presentation after 2131. (Paul Choroszy, ME 1-13)

CHINA Beijing, 6290, in CH 2316-2327\*. Very strong w/ W annr between haunting CH melodies. (Moritz, OH 1-23)\*\*\*A regular here during local mornings. tba

\*\*\*CLANDESTINE R. Misquot (sp?), 6680-85, in lang 0300. New clandestine and not at all sure of spelling but sounds like "miscoat." Many IDs for that noted and a number of references to Nicaragua. Mostly M annr but a W noted at times, too. Dave Valko tells me he had them on 6915 on 1-21. Also noted on 6865 1-24 0300-0330 this time w/ strong signals. Seems to b'cast in an Indian dialect at times. Only mx a ranchera type number 0317. This followed by at least a dozen IDs. Still can't get spelling. Many mentions Nicaragua and comunistos. (Moritz, OH)---Same on highly variable center of 6870. Noted w/ USB only but some residual carrier. Believe proper spelling is Miscut, after local Indian tribe in Nicaragua. IDed as R. Miscut on 6870 in 41 meter band from 6 in morning to 8 in evening (this part garbled). Also stated that it was a new voice against atheistic communism. Most pgms in Miscut Indian dialect but does go into SP from time to time. Tnx Kirk Baxter for this tip. (Bob Rankin, KS)

COLOMBIA R. Bucaramanga, 4845, in SP noted w/ IDs in EG and FR and a short EG talk about \*\*\*Colombia. (Hans Johnson, TX 1-14)\*\*\*Time please? tba\*\*\* Confusion over activity on 4885: LV del Llano, noted 0207-40 on 1-25 w/ mix of folk tunes, ballads and SP pops. Many Llano IDs on this freq usually occupied by Ondas del Meta. Noted that it was announced as "emisora fundamental de la cadena super." Tnx Valko for telling me about move. (Moritz, OH)---Later monitoring here and by Wendell Cfaighead, also in KC shows that Ondas del Meta is still there and has simply joined the Super net. Local programming still carries Ondas del Meta IDs while net pgms are from Llano, the flagship stn. (tba) +++ R. Surcolombiana, 5010, in SP 0119-36; talk skow of some kind, apparent remote hook up. Annr and another person talking. Many mentions of Bucaramanga then of Bogota and Caracol. Seeming ID 0122 and at 0030 ads, reference to Colombia and back to talk. (Moritz, OH 2-4) +++R. Cinco, 5040, in SP 0300 mixing w/ Maturin. Also noted at 1128 w/ complete ID. (Field, MI)

ECUADOR R. Pastaza, 3315, in SP as follows: 1-13 0121-35; couple of ballads, deep voiced M annr, W on tape. A number of "R. Pastaza" IDs by M from 0127 during talk which continued to t/out. on 1-30, 0155-0203. First noted 0003 and returned to it w/ decent signal M w/ ID and again 0200. Into musica folklorico. On 2-6 running late 0600-12 w/ some kind of concert. M at mike on stage or seemingly so. Many IDs. Nice folklorico mx. Good sigs in absence of usual QRM. (Moritz, OH)+++R. Splendit, 5025, tentative in SP 0342-0432. Here w/ musica romanticos as said by annr 0411. Mostly mellow rock vocals by W groups until 0400 when ballads w/ a touch of folk to them. Some love songs by a couple of different Ws break from promo and short play of "Under Pressure" by David Bowie and Queen. Bad noise especially from 0425. Never caught an ID. (Moritz, OH 1-17)

ICELAND ISBS, 13797, in Icelandic w/ nx and wx. Piano IS. Vy good. (Choroszy, ME 1-13)\*\*\*Time?

INDIA AIR Hyderabad, 4800, tentative in lang 1246-1300. Talk by M in lang to 1300 then talk by W and quick fade. Fairly good sig but troubled by UTE. (Henry Lazarus, LA 1-28)
